- The Volunteer (WWOOFer) mentioned below, who I welcome to my farm/property, wishes to experience an ecological way of living and to get familiar with various methods of organic farming and of ecological practices in general, while voluntarily participating in the everyday farming chores and work taking place at my farm,
- the Volunteer wishes to voluntarily offer work in my farm, on his own free will, with no financial or other kind of remuneration, salary, or reward,
- the Volunteer is not a worker, nor does he/she substitute paid workers; no employment relationship, work or service contract, agency, or apprenticeship, exists between me and the Volunteer,
- I have no right to impose, or in any way demand, that the Volunteer offers his/her work, nor do I expect that the Volunteer is trained or qualified to carry out the tasks appointed to him/her,
- I will provide the Volunteer with friendly, safe and suitable accommodation during his/her stay at my farm/property, without asking or accepting any financial exchange,
- to the point that I can, I will help the Volunteer gain practical experience and knowledge in organic farming and ecological practices. However I do not guarantee the amount, extent or quality of such experience and knowledge,
- the schedule of the Volunteer's stay and of the voluntary activities in

which he/she will participate in, as well as the way in which these activities will be executed, depends entirely on the arrangements made between me and the Volunteer, always subject to the values and aims of volunteerism.

- In case my relationship with the Volunteer does not work out for any reason, I am entitled to ask him/her to leave my farm/property, giving him/her reasonable time to arrange his/her departure.

- I am a volunteer and my stay at the Host's farm/property is taking place on a voluntary and non-profitable basis, therefore I do not substitute a paid worker and no employment relationship, work or service contract, agency or apprenticeship, exists between me and the Host.
- I have freely chosen the period of my stay at the Host's farm/property, as I have freely chosen which voluntary work I wish to participate in.
- During my stay at the Host's farm/property I will respect and follow the time schedule I have already communicated to the Host prior to my arrival, I will act responsibly and timely to inform the Host of any change in my scheduled stay or in the voluntary activities and work I already chose to participate in prior to my arrival, to ensure the smooth operation of the

volunteer program.

- I wish to work voluntarily, always acting in a team spirit and always respecting the other volunteers, the Host, the volunteer schedule, and the way the Host's farm/property is run.
- I will respect and abide by all safety and health rules governing the operation and work of the Host's farm/property and abstain from any action or omission which could endanger me, others or the property of the Host or others.
- to safeguard the safety of myself and others I must comply with the Host's instructions as to the way work should be carried out.
- I am entirely responsible for having during my stay at the Host's farm/property a valid life and health insurance, and insurance against accidents and liability against others.
- I am looking forward to gaining practical experience and knowledge on various organic farming techniques and ecological practices in general, although I am aware at the same time that no guarantee is provided by the Host as to the extent and quality of such experience and knowledge.
- the schedule of my stay and of the voluntary activities in which I will participate in, as well as the way in which these activities will be executed, depends entirely on the arrangements made between me and the Host, always subject to the values and aims of voluntarism.
- In case my relationship with the Host does not work out for any reason, I am entitled to leave the volunteer program and the Host's farm/property after having informed the Host, giving him/her reasonable time to arrange alternative volunteers.

**Other terms of the Volunteer program:**

The host shall mow at his own expense (gas, oil, etc.). But after the 5th occasion, gas sufficient enough to mow the property will be supplied thereafter.

The Volunteer shall have access to shared areas: kitchen, bathroom, barn, lockable storage and be provided with utilities including water, electricity, air conditioning and heating, refrigerator, but the Volunteer will pay all fees for,

phone, router and internet service if desired. Other terms shall be negotiated in the event that other Volunteers arrive--whether e.g. to share internet costs, who shops for groceries, cooks, when and where does each person eat, sleep, clean and how to share storage space.

**House Rules:**

No smoking or illicit drugs anywhere on the farm.

No illegal activities.

Guests allowed only with prior notice/approval.

Quiet hours: [10pm-7am].

Keep the place clean.

Though not responsible for normal wear and tear, the Volunteer must notify Owner promptly of any damage or needed repairs and pay for any damages if responsible e.g. breaking a window, burning anything, leaving propane on and draining a full tank, burning a coffee pot, hitting and damaging anything with one's vehicle, and so on.
